Sports Premium Grant Report September 2015-2016

Sports Premium

Through the 'Sport Premium', the government provides funding to support the delivery of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding – provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport – and will be allocated directly to primary schools across England.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

In 2015/2016 St Lawrence's Sports Premium Grant was £8,335.00

Purpose of funding

Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

Possible uses for the funding might include:

- hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers when teaching PE
- supporting and engaging the least active children through new or additional Change4Life clubs
- paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- running sport competitions, or increasing pupils' participation in the School Games
- buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport
- providing places for pupils on after school sports clubs and holiday clubs

Telford and Wrekin Sports Partnership Access to school sports coordinators, PE coordinators, network meetings, staff CPD and inter school competitions.	£400.00	T&W Sports Partnership meetings, CPD for staff. Entry to competitions for all children. Allowing children to participate in sporting competitions against other schools. These competitions include football, athletics, tennis and archery.
Educating Kids Outdoors session	£158.00	Getting the children outside in the fresh air experiencing new skills.
Transport to sporting fixtures and swimming lessons	£1000.00	
Resources as required to support PE and sport in school	£800.00	Children are engaged on healthy active play at lunchtimes whilst acquiring and practising new skills.
Administration arranging inter school competitions, arranging transport of pupils and letters to parents.	£1,000.00	To ensure the school can enter sporting fixtures that would otherwise have been impossible without transport, giving children the opportunity to get involved and put into practice their newly acquired skills.
Teaching assistant to escort pupils on competitions	£1,000.00	To ensure the school can enter sporting fixtures that would otherwise have been impossible without the support of a teaching assistant accompanying the children.
Training for staff in specialist areas e.g. swimming	£110.00	Enhance and sustain the high quality of PE being delivered from teachers by supporting and providing CPD.
