

Religious Education

Alongside our collective worship in school and visits to church, Class 3 will be learning about what it means for God to be holy and loving, and then we will be learning about what it means to live as a Hindu today.

DT/ART

Forest Schools will continue and run throughout the year in our fantastic forest school area in school. Dates for our forest school sessions will be announced before hand.

In Art this term, we will be exploring line, tone, texture, form and colour. We will be using Antarctica as our inspiration for creating a story-board.

MUSIC

In music, Class 3 will be learning about rhythm and dynamics. Children will be shown how to read and compose music using accurate formations of semi quavers, quavers, crotchets, minims and semibreves.

English

This year, throughout school, we are continuing to develop our Jane Considine whole school reading and writing approach. In reading, children will access a variety of extracts and use reading skills, focused on a specific 'lens' to 'dig deeper' into texts and answer questions. Children will also access traditional longer comprehensions to help to develop the comprehension skills necessary. In writing, this term, our topic of 'Significant Journeys' will offer the stimulus and the children will access various genres starting with narrative writing. SPAG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) and will take place weekly.

ICT

In ICT this term, we will be covering and learning about E-safety. After half term, Class 3 will be doing coding and computer science.

PSHE

In Class worship we are continuing to learn about our school values. In PSHE lessons, we are currently looking at managing our emotions and after half term we will be talking about managing risks.

Languages

This term we will be learning Spanish. We will be taught about the different countries that Spanish is spoken. We will be learning basic sounds, basic greetings, numbers 1-20, colours, shapes and how to introduce ourselves.

Science

In Science this term, our topic is Light and Shadows. We will be investigating and experimenting on how the position of the light source, shining on an object, can change the shadow's size and shape.

We will be investigating whether all objects cast shadows and explaining our findings scientifically.

History/ Geography

In History and Geography this term, our topic is Significant Journeys where we will be discussing what a journey means to us and learning about explorers such as Ernest Shackleton and his journey to Antarctica.

In Geography, we will be locating the UK on a map of the world and learning about where its rivers, landmarks, cities and counties are positioned. We will be researching our own county, Shropshire, and finding out about its geographical features.

Numeracy

This term we will be focusing on the following Numeracy areas: Place Value, Fractions and the four operations. Each week we will be doing an arithmetic lesson where many aspects of maths will be revisited on a weekly basis.

Lessons will as always aim to improve mathematical fluency as well as developing reasoning and problem solving skills. Children will also be encouraged to explain how they have calculated answers to problems and to verbalise this clearly.
