Friday 24h January 2020

Firstly, please can I remind parents that on Tuesday 4th February we will be holding a Phonic Workshop for Parents of children in Class 1 at 2.30pm in the school hall. If parents of children in Class 2 would like to attend also as a refresher you would be most welcome. I will be revisiting the Read, Write, Inc Phonics Scheme that we currently use in school as well as supporting parents with strategies to support their child at home with early reading. On the same day Mrs Standish will be holding a KS2 SATs Meeting with parents of children in Year 6 at 3.15pm. This will provide parents with an opportunity to find out about the statutory assessments at the end of Key Stage 2 which take place in May and ask any questions about this process. We look forward to welcoming you into school on this day.

Mrs Leon is currently undertaking ELSA training and will be a fully qualified Emotional Literacy Support Assistant here at St. Lawrence by the end of her programme of study. ELSAs help children and young people learn to understand their emotions and provide time and space for pupils to think about their personal circumstances and how they can manage their feelings. As emotional health and well being is at the forefront we believe that having a member of staff trained will benefit our pupils and support the work already taking place.

As a school we place high priority on reading and here at St. Lawrence we view reading as 'the window to the world.' A child's reading skills are important to their success in school as it helps them access the breadth of the curriculum and improve their language and communication skills. In addition, reading is a fun, imaginative time for children, opening doors to all kinds of new worlds for them. With this in mind, we have noticed an increasing amount of children not reading at home and not practising the skills of reading. We need your support as your time dedicated to reading stories and reading individually with your child will improve their word recognition, vocabulary and comprehension. Please could you sign the reading agreement in front of the reading diaries and record times when you have read at home. Having parents in partnership with school significantly helps confidence and fluency.
