We are continuing to make stronger links with the local secondary schools and wherever possible we are organising contact and visits to support transition for our Year 6 pupils.

This week in school we had our SEND Review, as part of this process SEND provision throughout school is looked at and staff, pupils and parents are interviewed to give their views. 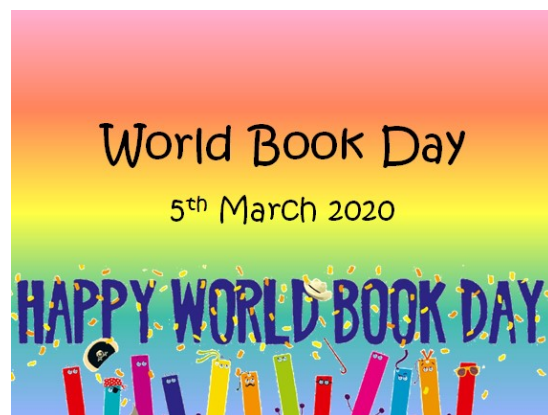
Pancake Day—Tuesday 25th February
