Dear Parents and Carers,

**Potential reopening of the schools, week beginning 1.6.20: Y6, Y1, Reception and children of Key Workers.**

Following on from the message we sent out earlier this week in relation to the government announcement that schools may be reopening for some pupils from as early as 1<sup>st</sup> June, we require some information to enable us to plan and risk assess the potential re opening of certain classes.

The groups identified by the national government are **Y6, Y1 and Reception pupils**

We would like to know from parents of the Y6, Y1 and reception pupils if they will be choosing to send their children on return to school. We would like to draw your attention that the return to school at this stage is a parental choice and there will be no repercussions on lack of attendance should you decide not to send your children.

We also need to know how many **Key Worker parents and carers** will also require a place for their children.

The safety of all pupils, staff and parents is the priority. We follow and continue to adhere to national and local authority guidelines to ensure the safest environment we can manage, reducing the risks of transmission as much as possible.

The decision to return your child to school rests with you, the parents or carers.

If the school does open for some year groups from week beginning 1<sup>st</sup> June, pupils will be taught in much smaller groups to reduce the number of people in classrooms and the potential risks of transmission. The adult leading that group may not be your child's class teacher but another teacher or teaching assistant. The school will not be providing places for siblings from other year groups but will continue to be open for Key Workers children from other year groups, as we are now.

We are very much aware that Y6 may well be keen to meet up with friends. This is their last period of time at primary school and they will miss the end of primary celebrations and markers of transition to secondary school. Be assured, that we will plan for something in the Autumn Term for this group in order to ensure this significant moment isn't missed, even if it is a bit late.

We will be sending more information as we are able, but for now, please could you email the school with your responses to the 2 questions below.
