This week the Governing Body of the Tibberton and St. Lawrence Federation have been in the process of conducting interviews for the Executive Head Teacher appointment, our Chair of Governors, Mr Paul Evans, will be updating parents next week on the outcome of this process. As part of the interview process, some of the children attending school currently at St. Lawrence got to interview in the candidates in a virtual capacity. The information received from the government suggests that from September all children will be in school on a full-time basis. We are currently awaiting government guidance on this and will be in communication when we receive direction on this. As a school we place high importance on transition and understand how important this is for our pupils, with this in mind, we will be inviting pupils back for a one hour session in the penultimate week to have a 'Story and Snack' with the teacher who will be teaching them in the new academic year. We will also be inviting our year 6 pupils back in the last week of term so that they get to finish the St. Lawrence journey with us and meet up with their friends and teachers for one last time.
