Dear Parents,

2..20pm (Led by Mr Worpole) Y3 (In school) and Y4.

We hope that this organisation makes sense to you as we have had to consider Y3 pupils accessing our key worker places who form part of Bubble B. Unfortunately, this group of children won't be able to join their own class as this would involve crossing bubbles. A Parentmail will be sent out with the 'zoom' invite for classes. Class 1 and Class 2 invites will be the same username and passcode as the timings have not changed.

In addition to this, Mrs Nash will be offering a Friday Worship session for those children working from home. The link to the invite for next Friday will have been sent out today via Parentmail but is here for you again if you have missed it.
