



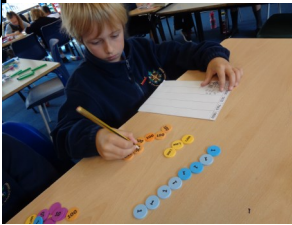
Class 3 Weekly News

In maths, the focus has been place value and children have been working on numbers to 100 and 1000. We enjoyed creating numbers using base 10 and counters which helped us to partition numbers.
