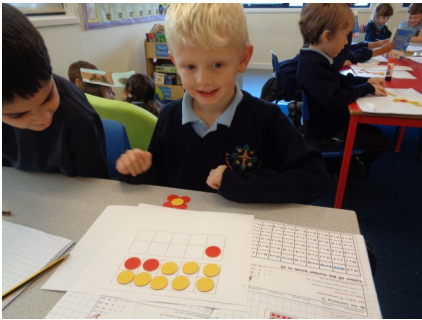
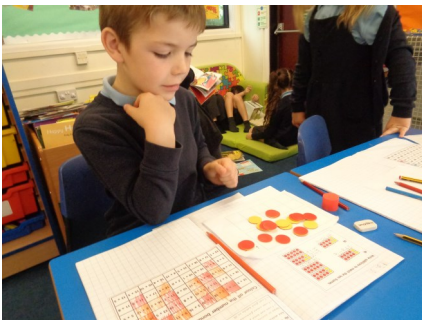


Class 2



Our work in Maths this week focused on making 10 when adding in Year 1. The children learnt that in a sum such as $6 + 5$, we can use our bonds to turn this into $10 + 1$.

Seeing bonds within a calculation is a big step for Year 1 mathematicians and the children did brilliantly with this concept.



In Year 2, we took further steps to adding 2 digit numbers, exploring 10 more or 10 less of numbers within 100. The children did brilliantly with this and after half term, we will be moving onto formal addition within 100.



In our PSHE curriculum focus of 'Myself and My Relationships', the children have looked at the concepts of 'strengths and weaknesses', 'ways to manage some of our feelings' and 'recognising emotions in others'.

We have had some excellent discussions during these lessons and the children have shared times that they have felt different emotions, strengths of theirs and things they find tricky.
