

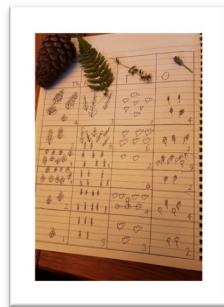


# Class 3 Weekly News
