It turns out that the playground and field are longer, but not by much!

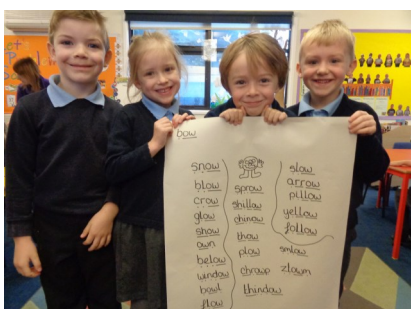


We had a guest author visit us in school this week - Sarah Griffiths. The children absolutely loved this and were full of questions about the story and life as an author.
