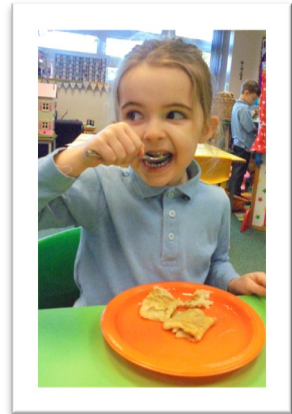
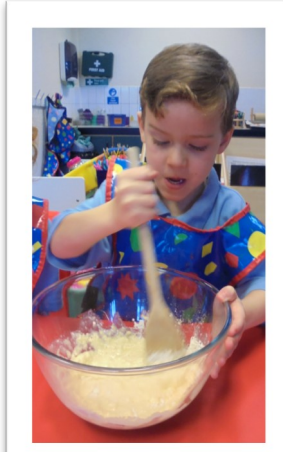
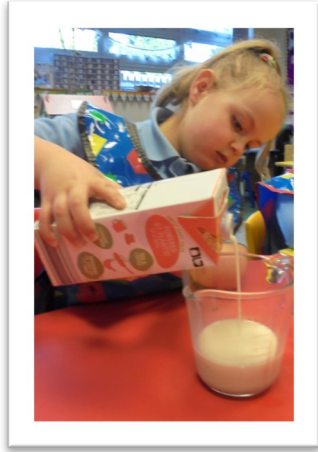
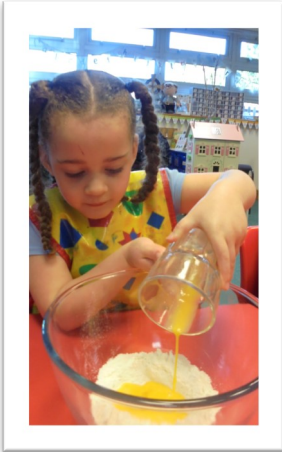




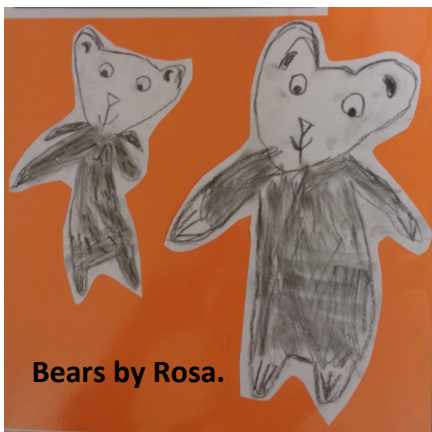
Class 1
