



Class 3 Weekly News

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What a lovely start to the last half term before the summer break we have had in class 3! The children have settled back into their learning really well and we have had a week full of lots of hands-on science fun!





This week we have been investigating how light travels and reflects. We used different types of paper and predicted which ones would be the most reflective. We then used torches to shine on the different types of paper to test our predictions. We learned that black paper absorbs light and the shiny paper reflected the light. We thought that the bumpy, shiny paper would be the most reflective but it was actually the flat shiny paper that was the most reflective.

We also punched a hole in paper and shined a light through to see how light travels. We discovered that light always travels in a straight line!



As well as science, we have been learning how to tell the time this week. The children have really enjoyed using different methods to support their learning and have really challenged themselves. Well done Class 3!
