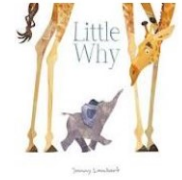
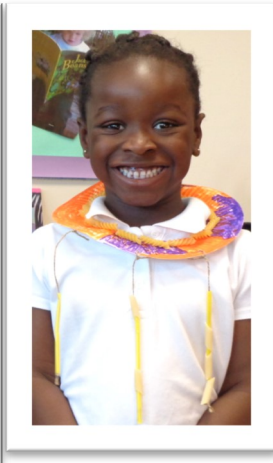
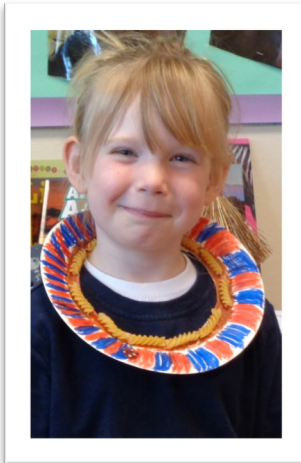




Class 1
