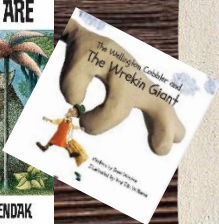
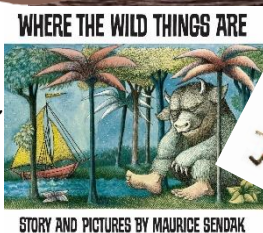

Phonics

Children will continue to participate in daily phonics sessions following our Read, Write, Inc Approach. Children will have a decodable text based upon the sound that has been taught in the session. This needs to be read 3 times at home to practise and reinforce skills.



Maths

In maths we will be focusing on:

Art

Explore, Experiment, Create

Paper Art - investigate different types of paper and explore their different textures and features, before using a variety of techniques to create artwork from paper.



Science

Engaging Science - Habitats 2.6

Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats
Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain.
Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other



Geography

What do we know about the Wrekin?

(Spring 1) – Local Landmarks

Children will be learning to use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language [for example, near and far; left and right], to describe the location of features and routes on a map.

Computing

Our unit on Internet Safety will look at how websites keep us safe, who can help us if we feel unsafe and how to keep ourselves safe online.
