Phonics

Children will continue to participate in daily phonics sessions following our Read, Write, Inc Approach. Children will have a decodable text based upon the sound that has been taught in the session. This needs to be read 3 times at home to practise and reinforce skills.

Begin to select tools and materials; use correct vocabulary to name and describe them.

Build structures, exploring how they can be made stronger, stiffer and more stable

Observe changes across the four seasons and weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies the living world e.g. hibernating animals, plants in drought areas, monsoon periods.

Computing systems and networks

Pupils should be taught to recognise common uses of information technology beyond school.

Music

Combining pulse, rhythm and pitch.

Rhythm Recognise long sounds and short sounds, and match them to syllables and movement. Play copy back rhythms, copying a leader, and invent rhythms for others to copy on untuned and tuned percussion. Create rhythms using word phrases as a starting point.
