Look carefully at each image in the photo pack and answer the questions linked to it.

**Photo 1**

What do you think is happening in this picture?  
 This is a picture of local people that had to hide in the underground and sleep there. In the morning they would get dressed and leave to go home or to work. This photo was taken in 1940, London, U.K.

How do you think the people in this picture were feeling at the time?  
 They would have had mixed feelings, they would be happy that they had someone to talk to and someone to go. Sad because they were tired of leaving their homes every night.

**Photo 2**

What do you think the man in this picture is doing?  
 The man could be looking for someone or something. There are a few air raid shelters so maybe he is looking for someone who was in it at the time.

**Photo 1**

What do you think is happening in this picture?  
 This is a photograph of a underground Station in London. People would stay there over night to keep safe from the blitz. People would sleep, eat, knit or read to occupy time. This photo was taken in May 1940, London.

How do you think the people in this picture were feeling at the time?  
 They would have been scared because of the noise, happy because no bombs are around them. They might have felt uncomfortable because they are sleeping on the ground. Sad because they were tired of leaving their homes.

**Photo 2**

What do you think the man in this picture is doing?  
 He is looking in the rubble for something or someone. He might be looking out the rubble for his house or a friend or neighbour. There is an air raid shelter in the photo.
