Dear Parents,

Another scorcher of a week! The children have been so sensible in talking about sun safety and seeking out shade when they are hot. Please remember to send them in with hats and water bottles so that we can help keep them cool(ish) during the day.

We had visits from lots of different people this week, from Hoola Nation to Bhangra dancing, from school nurses to Telford & Wrekin Safeguarding board, as well one of our Governors, Mrs Sands. A big well done on how well you all conducted yourselves- as always, their feedback was outstandingly positive and they all mentioned what wonderful, happy children we have. I hope that the children have told you about all the different things they have done as part of healthy lifestyles week- look out for photos on the website and later in the newsletter.

As part of this, we have been reviewing our Healthy Eating Policy in line with Local Authority and Food Standards guidance. We have spoken to the children this week about new expectations around snacksfrom Monday 19th June, these can only be a piece of fruit or a portion of dried fruit. We do always have fruit in school, so if a child needs something we can provide this for them. Lunchboxes can contain crips and a biscuit, as part of a healthy balanced diet. Thank you in advance for your support with this; childhood obesity is a growing issue within Telford & Wrekin authority, and Nationally, so we need to do our part to combat this.

The PTA are busily planning the summer fair which is set to be a lovely event. If you have any other donations of bottles, smellies, sweets etc that you can make, these will be accepted all next week. Thank you in advance for the donations in exchange for the mufti day- this is all much appreciated in helping to raise money for the children. Also, if you think you might be able to help on a stall or with setting up/ tidying away, please get in touch with the PTA via the school office. Thank you.

This week, I have been talking to the children and staff about the school gate and the expectations around entering school in a morning. Please can I ask that you keep your children with you until the gate is open. This is to prevent any accidents whilst waiting to come into school. We will be expecting the children to wait calmly and patiently, and then to enter the school gate, walking smartly, and head sensibly to their class. Once again, thank you for your continued support; I know some of you have reached out to me this week, and I am pleased that we can continue to work together to make school the best it can be for all of our pupils.
