Dear Parents

We have reached the beginning of Advent- a hugely important time in the Christian calendar as we prepare to celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ. Advent is a gift that invites us to slow down, and enjoy the hope, joy and love that God offers us in his son.

Everyone is also busy preparing in school for nativities, services, parties and events - please check the dates section on the newsletter for more information; we are looking forward to sharing this festive time of joy with you all.

A plea again from me- most children are coming to school well wrapped-up and with layers to keep them warm during the day. There are, however, a few children without coats- we really must insist that all children wear a coat for outdoor play when the weather is cold and frosty.

As you know, Mrs Moore left her post as Head of school at St Lawrence last year and I have been acting as Head as well as Executive head for the first term. I am pleased to share with you some staffing changes that come into effect today, that will enable a more effective distribution of responsibility, and provide you with a clear route of who to speak to in both schools.

Mrs Hemmings (St Lawrence) and Ms Wilkinson (Tibberton) have been appointed as Assistant Headteacher at their base schools, and we are looking forward to widening the senior leadership team. I remain in my Executive headteacher role, so will continue to be involved with all pupils and families across the federation.

If you remain unhappy and feel the matter is not resolved, then you will be able to escalate this to me, in line with the complaints policy.

We have looked at stained glass windows that tell the nativity story and created our own.




# Pantomime trip ....


