CLASS 1

Another fantastic week of learning in Class 1. We have been learning about a new vehicle text The squirrels that squabbled. We have explored the text and predicted what we thought might happen next. The children gave lots of lovely ideas and have written some amazing predictions. In Maths, we have continued learning about bonds within 10 and adding amounts. Reception have been focusing on the composition of number 4 and 5 and one less than a given number.

In our foundation subjects we have been learning about growth, survival and holidays now and then.

CLASS 2

This week class 2 have worked really hard on their first assessment point this year. They have shown fantastic resilience and tried their best. I am super proud! In PSHE this week we focused on how we can stand up for ourselves and others when they are being bullied and looked at why people might be bullied, I was impressed with their knowledge of the protected characteristics.
